APPLICATION PROCEDURES

- Completed application form (all other requirements can be submitted as available prior to the application deadline)
- Official transcripts (from all accredited colleges you have attended, and noting receipt of undergraduate degree)
- \$60 application fee
- Portfolio (All images must be stored on a standard 4.75" CD-R compact disk. Save images in a JPG format with a maximum of 72 pixels per inch (dpi). Attach an 8.5" x 11" printed fact sheet that includes title, media, dimensions and date of completion of each piece. If you are submitting your portfolio on-line, please send us your complete URL address. Please also refer to program specific requirements below)
- TOEFL score of 550 (paper), 213 (computer) or 79 (internet) or IELTS score of 6.5 (if English is your second language)

Portfolio Requirements:

- A digital portfolio of recent artwork demonstrating evidence of studio practice (10 to 15 images)
- Evidence of working knowledge of Powerpoint, such as a classroom project or personal artwork demonstrating its use
- Evidence of writing skills, including at least one research paper demonstrating use of citations and references

DUAL PROGRAM: MA in ART EDUCATION with an Emphasis in Special Populations with Certification

- 3.0 minimum GPA
- 43.5 Studio art credit hours
- 15 Credit hours of art history including 3 credits from outside western tradition
- 1.5 Credit hours of digital imaging or working experience equivalent
- 6 Credit hours of Math
- 6 Credit hours of English
- On-site interview
- Portfolio
- Statement of intent
- 3 letters of recommendation*

All College transcripts will be evaluated by the Admission's Office to determine eligibility of previous course work for those interested in certification. An application to each program is required with the application fee waived for the MA program

* Exceptions will be made in some cases for those with a BA or BS in Art Education without certification with significant teaching experience, or a BFA not in Art Education with significant teaching experience.

Portfolio Requirements/ Certification Portfolio:

- A digital portfolio of 15-20 slides of digital images of your artwork including some observational drawings e.g., still life and/or figure

Portfolio Requirements:

- 10 to 15 pieces that show evidence of free hand drawing. In addition, the portfolio must contain a minimum of 3 pieces in other media that show an interest in the built environment, and at least 2 observational drawings of an interior space. Evidence of competency in architectural plans, elevation sections and axonometric views is recommended. Students whose portfolio does not exhibit competence in architectural plans, elevations and sections are required to take the spring workshop to develop these skills.
- A 3 to 5 page writing sample demonstrating the ability to perform academic writing
